Laura Hall is best known as the improvisational pianist on television's WHOSE LINE IS IT ANYWAY? But her favorite project has been her two cds of original Contemporary Christian music, A WOMAN OF FAITH and ALL IN GOD'S GOOD TIME. She has also been featured on compilation cds; DREAM ON SISTER, A CHURCH WITH A VISION and the upcoming FAITH ROCKS.

Laura has toured the country performing at churches, concerts, and regional events. She feels blessed to have been a featured performer at the 2007 General Assembly and the Mix in '06 Women's Quadrennial. She is excited to be back at General Assembly, and looking forward to the 2010 Quadrennial, where one of her compositions has been chosen as the theme song.

Laura also has cds of original music for children, I SEE A TIGER and COME JOIN THE PARADE. She composed music for the TELL ME A STORY series of cds, a collection of folktales from around the world. She wrote music for a series of children's videos, THE WHEELS ON THE BUS, starring Roger Daltrey. She has written music for several independent films, including an award winning Holocaust documentary, SWIMMING IN AUSCHWITZ, and short films, ANATOMY OF A BREAKUP and SLICE OF PIE. He also wrote a one man show, PIGBOY, which was chosen for the HBO Comedy Art Festival in Aspen, and enjoyed successful runs in Los Angeles, Chicago, and a tour of the Midwest.
