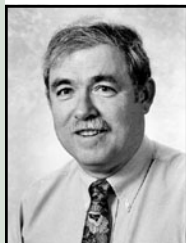


Missouri School of Religion presents:

Church Money Matters is a workshop for pastors, church leaders and members. We will discuss why a healthy and open approach to congregational funds is beneficial to the church. We will look at how outside entities exert influence on the church and money.
